About this map

This map is intended to assist residents and visitors in finding routes to shop, socialize and go to work/school by bicycle. The "comfortable" designation is based on low-to-medium traffic speeds & volumes along with other criteria. This map also shows signed bike routes. While some portions of the routes aren't ideal, they are judged to be the best available.

Remember that road conditions vary with time of day and day of the week. Increased traffic during rush hour may call for extra caution. The user of this map bears the full responsibility for his/her own safety.

About I Bike KXN

I Bike KXN promotes bicycling as part of the overall transportation system. We are housed within the Knoxville Regional Transportation Planning Organization and work to implement the Regional Bicycle Plan.

Bicycling tips

Bicycles are vehicles; bicyclists have the same rights as other drivers and have to follow the same rules. That includes stopping at red lights and stop signs. Never ride against traffic.

At intersections, stay in the right-most lane that goes to your destination. Stay far enough from the curb to avoid hazards like bad drain grates and broken glass. Stay at least 3' from parked cars to avoid getting hit if someone opens a car door.

Use lights when biking after dark. A white headlight is required, and a red taillight is recommended.

Riding on sidewalks is not recommended. If you do, be very cautious at all driveways and road crossings.

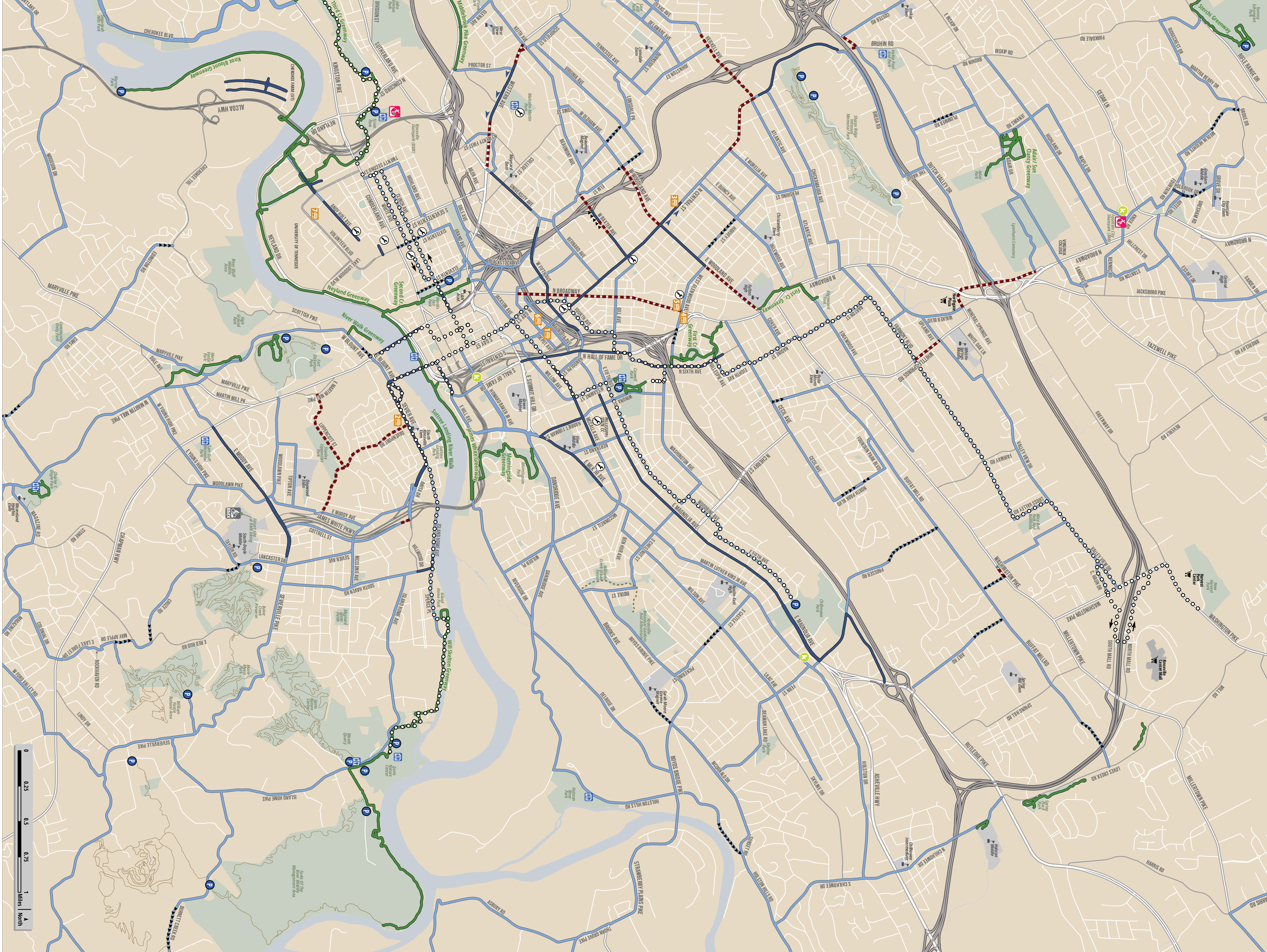

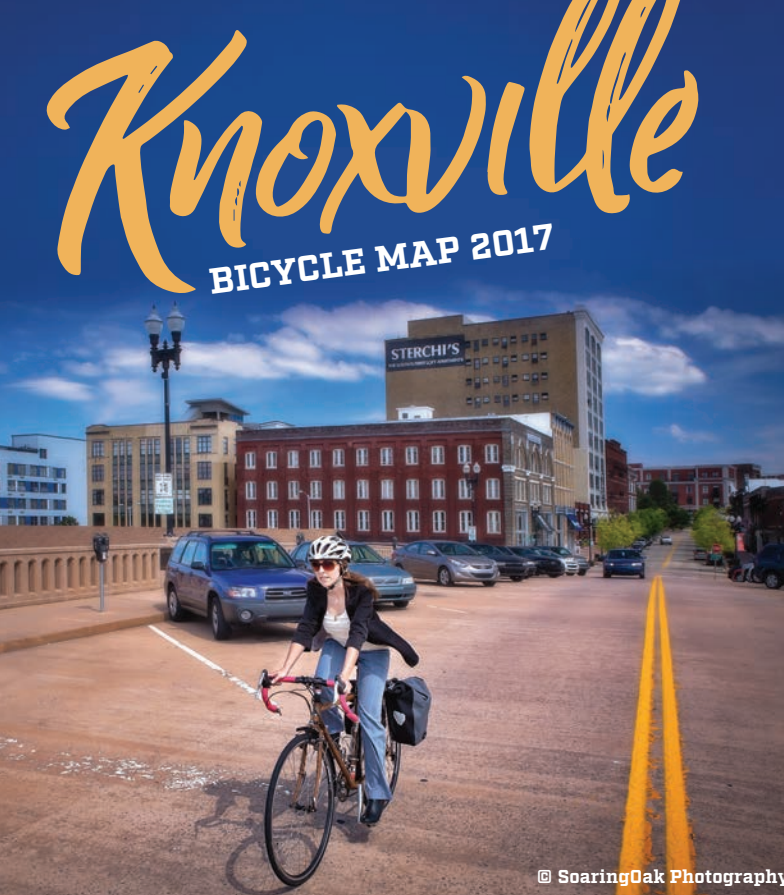
